

## Proposed Rules of the Windsurfer Class Association of Australia Incorporated

For approval at the incorporation meeting on 30th June 2026.

These proposed rules adopt the Model Rules prescribed under the Associations Incorporation Reform Regulations 2023 (Vic), with only the association's name, purposes and financial year completed as set out below.

### Rule 1 - Name

The name of the incorporated association is Windsurfer Class Association of Australia Incorporated.

### Rule 2 - Purposes

The purposes of the Association are:

1. to promote, develop and administer the sport of Windsurfer Class sailing in Australia;
2. to support participation at all levels, from entry-level recreational sailing to national and international competition;
3. to coordinate national events of the Class, including but not limited to an Australian Championship;
4. to act as the national class association for the Windsurfer LT one-design class in Australia, and for any other Windsurfer one-design class adopted from time to time by special resolution of the Association;
5. to represent Australian members of the Class internationally to the International Windsurfer Class Association (IWCA) and any other relevant international body;
6. to support and collaborate with affiliated clubs, state fleets and other organisations engaged in Windsurfer Class sailing in Australia;
7. to encourage inclusive and sustainable participation across all age groups; and
8. to do all things incidental or conducive to the above purposes.

### Rule 3 - Financial Year

The financial year of the Association is each period of 12 months ending on 30 June.

### Remaining Rules

Except for Rules 1, 2 and 3 as set out above, the Association adopts the Model Rules prescribed under Schedule 4 of the Associations Incorporation Reform Regulations 2023 (Vic) as its rules.
