

<b>Setting the slalom course</b>			
Anchor the starting boat.			
Determine the wind direction.			
Lay mark 1.	Lay Mark 3.	Lay Mark 2	Lay Mark 4
Lay Mark F	Lay Mark S.		
Determine the starter's position near the stern.			
Lay a mark at this point as close to the boat as possible.			
<b>Conducting the races</b>			
The referee boat should set up to windward of Mark 1			
This should be on the extension of the windward layline.			
Flag holder raises the Heat Number			
Begin the start procedure 1 minutes later.			
Timer calls each time point with a 10 second count down.			
Flag holder controls all flags.			
PRO calls clear start or recalls.			
Individual recalls should be preferenced to general recalls.			
PRO calls the finish and the timer records it.			
Flag holder raises the next Heat number after the last sailor finishes			
After the successful start of the next heat.			
The Flag holder transmits the results to the onshore committee.			
The Flag holder updates the on boat elimination ladder			
<b>On water Jury</b>			
The referee boat calls penalties at Mark 1 via loud hailer.			

On water sailor to sailor protests are conducted on the water.				
The Jury boat will anchor to leeward and between the start boats				
<b>On shore committee.</b>				
The PRO will advise when to raise a group flag on a course area flag				
The groups are called to the slalom course by raising their group flag				
The onshore committee shall advise the PRO of the time the flag is raised				
The finishing positions in each race will be sent by photo on a phone				
The back up is verbal transmission by phone or radio.				
The Elimination ladder is updated onshore.				
<b>General directions</b>				
The time allowance from the time the group flag is raised until the				
flag is raised for the first heat should be 20 minutes if the course is closed				
The time to complete a number of heats averages 10 minutes.				
So round 1 (heats 1 to 8) would take about 80 minutes				
The next 2 rounds ( heats 9 to 15 ) would take about 70 minutes.				
The 3 heat final requires a rest between heats so allow 45 minutes				
Alternatively run finals for two groups at once to save time.
